COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 464, L.D. 612, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Oxford County to Raise Money for the Development of an Airport in the Rumford-Mexico Area."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Development of Airport, Rumford-Mexico. The county commissioners of the County of Oxford are authorized to send to the people of the County of Oxford the following referendum question: Shall the county raise, by bonds, and expend a sum not to exceed \$107,500 for cost of developing an airport in the Rumford-Mexico area. This referendum shall occur at the next general or special state election after the following provisions have been met as determined by the Oxford County Commissioners:

1. Approval of a site by the Federal Aviation Authority;
2. Final cost estimates of the project have been approved by the Federal Aviation Authority;
3. An official airport authority has been formed by the participating municipalities;
4. The State's share of the cost of the airport has been approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require a referendum and to have these necessary facts before the referendum goes to the people.
