COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 470, L. D. 618, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Probation and Expungement of Records for
First-time Possession of Marijuana Offenders."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the 3rd paragraph
after the amending clause the following underlined sentence
'Any records not subject to expungement shall be exempt from
the provisions of Title 1, section 405.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the
last paragraph before the Statement of Fact the following:
'No cause of action against an individual shall arise as a
result of a violation of this section unless there is a showing
that such individual actively participated in or had knowledge
of the conduct which is alleged to have constituted the violation.'
