COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 473, L.D. 620, Bill, "AN ACT  
Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport Authority."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

Acquisition of property; right of eminent domain.

'Sec. 2./ Nothing contained in this Act shall be construed as  
authorizing said Authority to take by right of eminent domain any  
of the property or facilities of any other public service corporation  
or district used or acquired for future use by the owner thereof in  
the performance of a public duty, unless expressly authorized thereto  
in this Act or by subsequent Act of the Legislature.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 3 and  
4.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 5 to 14 to be  
3 to 12.

Statement of Fact

This amendment would exempt the taking of the property of a  
public service corporation by a public authority without express  
legislative authorization. Such a provision is customary in bills  
of this type.
