STATE OF MAINE SENATE 106TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "D " to H. P. 473, L. D. 620, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport Authority."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, a section 15, to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Referendum for ratification. This Act shall be submitted for approval or rejection to the qualified voters of the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn at the next general or special state-wide election and warrants shall be issued for such election in the manner now provided by law for holding of municipal elections, notifying the qualified voters of said cities of the date and purpose of the referendum. The city clerks shall prepare the required ballots, on which they shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following question:

"Shall 'AN ACT Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport
Authority, as enacted by the 106th Legislature, to correct the
present lack of direction in airport management and provide
professional planning for future development in a unified public
authority, be accepted?"

This Act shall take effect for all the purposes thereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters of the City of Lewiston voting at said meeting and by a majority of the legal voters of the City of Auburn voting at said meeting.

The result of the vote in said Cities of Lewiston and Auburn shall be declared by the municipal officers of the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn and due certificates thereof shall be filed by the clerks of said cities with the Secretary of State.'
