STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Include Full and Part-time Deputy Sheriffs and Part-time and Reserve Policemen under Workmen's Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 2, sub-§ 5, ¶ B, amended. The 2nd sentence of paragraph B of subsection 5 of section 2 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Policemen, part-time and reserve, and firemen, deputy sheriffs considered full or part-time, while rendering services, other than civil process, shall be deemed employees within the meaning of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

1. To include the classification of deputy sheriff in the bill.
2. There are currently no provisions for part-time deputy sheriffs, reserve or part-time policemen.
