SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 482, L.D. 626, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide Vocational Rehabilitation Services to Handicapped Persons."

Amend said Bill in the 3rd line after the enacting clause by striking out the figure "\$184,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$50,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 4 lines before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other \$25,000 \$25,000'
