**AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Municipalities to Remove Worthless
Trees within the Limits of Ways and Streets.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 3955, repealed. Section 3955 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 15 of chapter 394 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed as follows:

~~§ 3955. Disposition of worthless trees~~

~~The municipal officers of municipalities shall, before the first day of June of each year, cut, burn and destroy all dead or worthless apple trees, and all wild cherry trees within the limits of the public ways, streets and parks of their respective municipalities. For neglect or failure to perform such duties each of such officers shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.~~
