COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 500, L.D. 653, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Uniform Flag Law."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "flag" the following:
', except those flags having a historical significance, when'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line of section 2 (3rd line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "privately" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined word 'openly'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide an exception from the standards prescribed for flags being displayed for any United States flag having a historical significance and to replace the word "privately" in section 2 with the word "openly."
