COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 226, L. D. 661, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Judicial Review from Decisions of
the Banking Commissioner."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word
"hearing" in the 6th line (5th line in L. D.) the following
', upon the written request of any person with a substantial
interest,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th and
9th lines (6th and 7th line L. D.) of paragraph B of subsection
2 of that part designated "§8." of section 2 the following
underlined words and punctuation "or purchase of stock by
a bank holding company,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd
line (same in L. D.) of subsection 3 of that part designated
"§8." of section 2 the underlined figure "90" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined figure '15'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last
line of subsection 5 of that part designated "§8." of section 2 the
underlined figure "10" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined figure '11'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the first
line of subsection 6 of that part designated "§11."
of section 2 the underlined words and punctuation
"In its discretion, the" and inserting in place thereof

the underlined word 'The'
