## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Extending the Appeal Period under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1194, sub-§ 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of the last paragraph of subsection 2 of section 1194 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 29 of chapter 538 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

Subject to the provisions of subsection II, unless the claimant or any such interested party, within 7 10 calendar days after such notification was mailed to his last known address, files an appeal from such determination, such determination shall be final.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill would extend the appeal period for all parties due to postal services in many areas.
