COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A "to S.P. 229, L.D. 664, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Qualifying Foreign Corporations to do
Business in Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the
4th and 5th lines after the amending clause (3rd line in
L.D.) the following: "~~7-er~~ and as provided by some other
public law of this State" and inserting in place thereof
the following: '~~7-er-as-provided-by-some-other-public-law
of-this-State~~'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section
2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. R.S.,T. 13-A, §1215, sub-§2, repealed. Sub-
section 2 of section 1215 of Title 13-A of the Revised Statutes,
as enacted by section 1 of chapter 439 and as amended by section
20 of chapter 565, both of the public laws of 1971, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The language removed in section 1 is redundant and
unnecessary. The amendment to section 2 should have only
repealed subsection 2 of section 1215. It should not have
repealed subsection 1 as that is necessary to the law.
