COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to SP 231, L.D. 666, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Maine Property Insurance Cancellation Control Act."

Amend said bill by striking out all of the last sentence of the first paragraph of that part designated "§3050" and inserting in place thereof, the following:

'The reason shall accompany the notice of cancellation, together with notification of the right to a hearing before the commissioner within 15 days as provided herein.'

Further amend said bill by striking out all of the last sentence of the first paragraph of that part designated "§3051" and inserting in place thereof, the following:

'The reason shall accompany the notice of intent not to renew, together with notification of the right to a hearing before the commissioner within 15 days as provided.'

Statement of Fact

The amendments to sections 3050 and 3051 change the bill to require that a statement of reason must accompany the notices of cancellation or failure to renew.
