HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to S. P. 231, L. D. 666, Bill,  
"AN ACT Providing for the Maine Property Insurance  
Cancellation Control Act."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of "§3054."  
the following underlined sentence 'If the insurer does not  
meet the burden of proof, the Insurance Commissioner shall  
have the authority to order the policy to continue in effect.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make clear the authority  
of the Insurance Commissioner to continue a policy in effect  
if the insurer does not prove a reason to cancel or not to  
renew.
