COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 507, L.D. 672, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Uniform Program for Educational Leave for State Employees."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§723." by striking out all of the 2nd sentence (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The board shall consist of 3 members as follows: The Director of Personnel who shall serve as chairman of the board, the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services or his designee; and one member who shall be a state employee appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, to serve for a term of 3 years.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§724." by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'The board shall seek the advice of the department head concerned in reviewing the educational leave application of each employee.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a state employee shall be a member of the Advisory Board and that department heads shall be consulted regarding educational leave for department employees.
