HOUSE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 507, L.D. 672, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Uniform Program for Educational Leave for State Employees."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd line of that part designated "<u>§722.</u>" (same in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation: ",without State funding,"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§725.</u>" by inserting at the end of the first sentence, before the period, the following underlined words: <u>unless such leave is approved by</u> the board'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§725.</u>" by inserting in the 4th line from the end, after the underlined word "to" the following underlined word: 'further'

The purpose of this amendment is to insure continued state funding of leave programs until such time as the Advisory Board renders its initial report.
