HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 519, L. D. 684, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal the Seasonality Provisions of the Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words
"to Repeal" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Relating to'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

- 'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 26, §1192, sub-§5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 1192 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence: This section shall not apply to employees of hotels, restaurants, boys' and girls' summer camps and students.
- Sec. 3. R. S., T. 26, §1251, sub-§1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1251 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

 This section shall apply only to employees of hotels, restaurants, boys' and girls' summer camps and students.
- Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act shall become effective September 30, 1973.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt students and employees of hotels, restaurants and boys' and girls' summer camps from the bill.
