SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 519, L. D. 684, Bill,
"AN ACT to Repeal the Seasonality Provisions of the Employment
Security Law."


Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 8th
line (6th line in L. D.) the underlined figure "2" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined figure '3'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in
the 9th line (7th line in L. D.) the underlined figure "\$600"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$900'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will require $3/4$ ^{quarters} of work at the rate of
\$300 per quarter and \$900 in the base period to qualify for
unemployment benefits.
