# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Repeal the Seasonality Provisions of the Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 1192, sub-§ 5, amended. The first sentence of subsection 5 of section 1192 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

For each eligible individual establishing a benefit year on and after September 30, 1973, He he has been paid during his base period wages of at least \$600 \$200 for insured work in each of 2 different quarters in his base period and has been paid total wages of at least \$600 in his base period for insured work.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 26, § 1251, repealed. Section 1251 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective September 30, 1973.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the seasonality provisions of the Employment Security Law and amends the Employment Security Law to require unemployment insurance claimants to demonstrate attachment to the labor market.
