AN ACT to Exempt Methods of Payment for Laboratory Services provided to Persons Outside of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 2033, amended. Section 2033 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 380 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to payments for services rendered by a duly licensed owner or director of a laboratory when conducting business with persons outside of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this legislation is reflected in the title.
