AN ACT Relating to Reflectorized Bicycle Pedals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 29, § 1962, amended. Section 1962 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph :

On and after January 1, 1974, no person shall sell a new bicycle, or pedal for use on a bicycle, that is not equipped with a reflector on each pedal of such bicycle which is visible from the front and rear of the bicycle during darkness from a distance of 50 feet.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act requires that all bicycles sold in the State of Maine after January 1, 1974 be equipped with reflectorized pedals.
