AN ACT to Provide for Municipal Tax Maps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2205, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2205 to read as follows:

§ 2205. Municipal tax maps

Every municipality in the State shall, prior to January 1, 1980, have a tax map, so called, drawn. Said map shall show the boundary lines of each parcel of land in the municipality and shall be properly indexed. The tax map shall be maintained in an up-to-date manner. Said map shall be open to public inspection in a municipal office during business hours.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to improve and make more uniform taxation procedures in the cities and towns by requiring tax maps.
