COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 529, L. D. 711, RESOLVE,
Providing for a Feasibility Study of Marine Resources Development
in Washington County.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the title the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, a feasibility study of Marine resources development
in Washington County is vital to the economy and well-being of both
the county and the State of Maine; and

Whereas, such study should be commenced as soon as possible
to better utilize the Marine resources of Washington County; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for
the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out in the 2nd line
of the 2nd paragraph (same in L. D.) the figure "\$15,000" and
inserting in place thereof the figure '\$25,000'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting at the end, before
the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for an emergency clause and increase the appropriation from \$15,000 to \$25,000.
