**RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to Aid Town of Deer Isle in Constructing
Municipal Building.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Deer Isle; appropriation for constructing municipal building.
Resolved: There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the
General Fund to the Town of Deer Isle, Hancock County, the sum of \$25,000
to aid the town in the construction of a new municipal building, the old
municipal building having been destroyed by fire.
