**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Woodrow Bakeman of Castine for Property
Damage by Highway Construction.**

Woodrow Bakeman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Woodrow Bakeman the sum of \$2,500 to reimburse him for damage to his property caused by inadequate drainage of a culvert under the highway passing in front of his house.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Construction on State Aid Highway No. 5 in the Town of Castine caused property damage due to inadequate drainage of culvert under highway passing in front of Mr. Bakeman's home.
