RESOLVE, Designating the Bridge Across the Little Androscoggin River at Mechanic Falls as "The Sawyer Memorial Bridge."

Resolved: That in recognition of the many years of devoted and unselfish service rendered to the community of Mechanic Falls and the State of Maine by Edward F. and Violet P.
