SENATE AMENDMENT "A " H.P. 540, L.D. 722, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Nature of Foreclosure of Tax Lien Mortgages."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the first
paragraph after the amending clause and before the Statement
of Fact, the following underlined sentence:

'In the event the notice provided in this section has not been
given, the party named on said tax lien mortgage shall have the
right to redeem said real estate mortgage within 30 days after
the said notice.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to guarantee that the
equity of the town shall not be jeopardized.
