IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Designating Part of Route 219 as a State Highway.

Part of Route 219 as state highway; designated. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to designate that part of Route 219 commencing at the junction of Route 26 in West Paris, Oxford County extending to the junction of Route 133 in Wayne, Kennebec County, as a state highway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to remove the burden of upkeep from the small towns that Route 219 passes through.
