AN ACT Regulating Motor Vehicles Used to Transport Railroad
Employees to and from Work.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1199, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1199 to read as follows:

§ 1199. Motor vehicles to transport employees

The Public Utilities Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations to protect the health and safety of employees of a railroad who are transported by motor vehicle to and from work by the railroad.

Any violation of such rule and regulation shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect the health and safety of the employees.
