STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Clarify the Law Relating to Motor Vehicle Air Pollution Control System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2127, sub-§ 2, amended. The first paragraph of subsection 2 of section 2127 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 474 of the public laws of 1969 and as amended by chapter 522 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

No person shall operate any motor vehicle, except a stock race ear an antique motor car, motor vehicle using liquefied petroleum gas as engine fuel or farm tractor, upon any highway of this State if any operational element of the air pollution control system of such vehicle has been removed, dismantled or otherwise rendered inoperative or in other than good working order.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove ambiguity between this section and section 115 of Title 29 which forbids operation of a stock car on the highway.
