STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Unofficial Certificates of Motor Vehicle Inspection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No person shall make, have in his possession, issue or knowingly use any imitation or counterfeit of an official certification certificate of inspection or have in his possession, issue or knowingly use a certificate of inspection that was not issued by an official inspection station in accordance with this Title or the rules and regulations promulgated by the Chief of the State Police governing motor vehicle inspection.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit control of official inspection stickers that are being handled illegally for the purpose of circumventing the law and the intent of the motor vehicle inspection program.
