STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc.; reimbursed. Resolved: That the indebtedness in the amount of \$430 of South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc., for the sales tax due the State of Maine on an ambulance purchased on March 6, 1972 is discharged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The corporation volunteer nonprofit ambulance corporation purchased an ambulance on March 6, 1972 and the sales tax due thereon is \$430. Two days later on March 8, 1972 the Governor approved an amendment to the sales tax law exempting such purchases from the sales tax.
