#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Sand Pond, Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 251, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 251 to read as follows:

### § 251. -Sand Pond, Oxford County

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by a motor in excess of 10 horse power on Sand Pond in Norway Township, Oxford County.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The camp owners on this pond have by letter indicated that boats in excess of 10 horse power are hazardous to safety on this small pond by endangering persons using smaller boats for fishing or relaxation and in instances have endangered young children in bathing areas.
