STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Require Public Hearings Prior to Certain Actions of Regional Planning Commissions and Council of Governments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 1983, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, additional. Subsection 1 of section 1983 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 5 of chapter 382 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new paragraph D, to read as follows:
- D. The council of governments shall hold a public hearing on any matter of substance considered by the council unless no action is contemplated as the result of said consideration.
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 4504, sub-§ 3, \P G, additional. Subsection 3 of section 4504 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph G, to read as follows:
- G. The commission must hold a public hearing prior to adopting a plan.
