HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 562, L. D. 741, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Furloughs to Inmates or Prisoners from County Jails."

Amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said bill in the 2nd line after the amending clause (first line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "for"the underlined punctuation and words ', subject to approval by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections,'

Further amend said bill by adding at the end of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact the following underlined sentence: 'Any person sentenced to a county jail 60 days or less shall not be eligible for furlough under this section except in the case of hospitalization for medical reasons.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to make regulations established by the sheriff also subject to approval by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections and to further clarify eligibility for furlough under the bill.
