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**RESOLVE**, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law for Addie M. Knox of Belfast.

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**Addie M. Knox of Belfast; retirement allowance. Resolved:** That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, Addie M. Knox of Belfast shall receive the minimum retirement allowance for 10 years service as provided under the State Retirement Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Present law permits \$80 per month to a person who has 10 years of creditable service rendered after July 1, 1942. Mrs. Knox was employed with the Parks and Recreation Department from June 1963 and was recently retired at age 70. She lacked one week of service to attain the 10 years credit for the minimum retirement allowance.
