COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 566, L. D. 745, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Active Retired Judges  
of the District Court."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line before the Statement of  
Fact (7th line of L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word  
"Court" the following: ', provided that his acceptance of an  
appointment as an Active Retired Judge would not constitute a  
waiver of his right to the compensation mentioned in section  
157-A'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that by  
accepting an appointment as an Active Retired Judge under section  
157-B, a retired Judge of the District Court would not be waiving  
his right to the compensation provided for in section 157-A.
