AN ACT Relating to the Length Limit of Striped Bass.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, c. 417, sub-c. II, Article 6-A, additional. Subchapter II of chapter 417 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new Article 6-A to read as follows:

Article 6-A. Striped Bass

§ 4111. Sale or possession of striped bass

No person shall sell or offer for sale, or have in his possession, any striped bass measuring less than 16 inches from the apex of the fork of the tail to the farthest extremity of the head. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 for each such fish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish the minimum length for striped bass at 16 inches.
