HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 276, L.D. 764, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Outdoor Advertising License and Permit Fees and Extend Controls."

Amend said Bill in the 6th line of section 5 (5th line of L.D.) by striking out the figures "25 35" and inserting in place thereof the following figure '25'

Further amend said Bill in the 11th line of section 8 (8th line of L.D.) by striking out the figures "~~700~~ 760" and inserting in place thereof the following figure '700'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the bill back to the original law as to maximum height and maximum area.
