COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" H.P. 579, L.D. 768, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Definition of and Licenses of Rectifiers under the Liquor Law."

Amend said bill by striking at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec.1."

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 10th line (8th line of L.D.) after the enacting clause, after the underlined word and punctuation "gin," the word and punctuation 'wine,'

The purpose of this amendment is to delete "wine" from the bill.
