COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 578, L. D. 770, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Repair, Maintenance and Operation of
State-owned Dam on Dead River, Androscoggin County."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Androscoggin Dam; repair, maintenance and
operation. The State of Maine shall maintain, repair and
operate the state-owned dam on Dead River in the Town of
Leeds, Androscoggin County, and the State Soil and Water
Conservation Commission shall act as the representative of
the State of Maine to oversee the same. Said dam shall
be maintained and operated to provide an optimum water
level of Androscoggin Lake so as to provide for the protection
of property, water quality, flood control and wildlife.
The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall
contract with the Androscoggin Lake Improvement Corporation
for the actual work of repair, maintenance and control of
the dam and shall reimburse that corporation for expenses
accrued.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The appropriation
shall remain a continuous carrying account until June 30, 1975.'
