STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Rehabilitation of Inmates Committed to the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, § 751, amended. The first paragraph of section 751 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The State Prison at Thomaston, in the County of Knox, shall continue to be maintained as the prison and penitentiary of the State in which convicts, lawfully committed thereto for confinement and rehabilitation of inmates lawfully committed thereto, who shall be confined employed and governed as provided by law.
