AN ACT Relating to State Political Committees to Determine Order of  
Business at State Conventions.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 401, sub-§ 1, repealed and replaced. Subsection 1 of section 401 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

1. Time, place, representation and order of business. The state committee of the party shall determine the time, place, basis of representation and order of business for the convention.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit state committees to determine the order of business for their conventions.
