### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to State Political Committees to Determine Order of Business at State Conventions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 21, § 401, sub-§ 1, repealed and replaced. Subsection 1 of section 401 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 1. Time, place, representation and order of business. The state committee of the party shall determine the time, place, basis of representation and order of business for the convention.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit state committees to determine the order of business for their conventions.
