STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Funds for Areawide Health Planning Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund the sum of \$250,000. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Provides funds for grants to Regional Health Planning Agencies established pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 246(b) and the funds here appropriated shall be pro-rated among existing regional health planning agencies according to their approved budgets as approved by the State Health Planning Agency.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Federal funds for approximately 50% of costs are available for area health planning activities; in Maine there are presently 5 such agencies.

Recent sweeping federal health program legislation reflects greatly increased responsibility and authority for state and local decisions to affect the quality of health care. These funds are necessary to assist local communities to improve their health care.
