SENATE AMENDMENT "B." to S. P.270, L. D. 795, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing Piscataquis County to Collect and Dispose of Solid Waste on a Regional Basis."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 30, §§417 and 418, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding 2 new sections to read as follows:

§417. Piscataquis County; solid waste

The county commissioners of Piscataquis County are empowered to contract with municipalities to collect and dispose of solid wastes. Each town or township under such contract may be assessed for the cost of such operation. §418. Amount of assessments determined

The county commissioners shall annually determine the amount of the assessments provided for in sections 415 and 417. In the case of municipalities, they shall include the amount of such assessments in their warrants to municipal assessors issued under section 254. In the case of unorganized townships, they shall certify the amount of such assessments to the State Tax Assessor not later than April 1st each year, and said amounts are appropriated from the General Fund to be credited annually on the books of the State to the proper fiscal officer of each county as provided in Title
