STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing Piscataquis County to Collect and Dispose of Solid Waste on a Regional Basis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 417, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 417 to read as follows:

§ 417. Piscataquis County; solid waste

The county commissioners of Piscataquis County are empowered to join with municipalities to collect and dispose of solid wastes. Each town or township may be assessed for the cost of such operation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to enable Piscataquis County to join with municipalities or other counties to form a regional solid waste disposal organization to study the feasibility of such regional system and to operate said system if such is the wish of governments involved.
