COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 612, L.D. 810, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Trapping Muskrats and Beaver on Lands of the
Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) the underlined
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following section:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2402, amended. Section 2402 of
Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by
section 9 of chapter 231 of the public laws of 1971, and as amended,
is further amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph a new paragraph
to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person not a member of the
Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians to trap for muskrat and beaver on all
lands and islands belonging to the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.'

It is the intent of this / to provide trapping laws on muskrat
and beaver for the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe.
