IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Municipal Official Conflict of Interest Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2251, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 2251 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- I. Voting. Where it would be decisive, the The vote by any official of a municipality in his official position on any question in which he has a direct or an indirect pecuniary interest is void.
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 2251, sub-§ 4, repealed. Subsection 4 of section 2251 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 247 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed.
