COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A " to S.P. 292, L.D. 839, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Permit Appointment of Judges of Probate."

Amend said Resolution by striking out in the last two lines (last 3 lines of L.D.) of the next to the last paragraph, before the statement of fact, the words "and the amendment shall thereupon, as of the date of said proclamation, become a part of the Constitution" and inserting in place thereof, the following:

'and the amendment shall become effective at such time as the Legislature by proper enactment shall establish a different Probate Court system with full-time judges'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is requisite if L.D. 839 is to be consistent with chapter 77 of the Resolves of 1967, which was subsequently approved by the vote of the people of Maine.
