COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 294, L.D. 841; RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Changing the Tenure of  
Office of Sheriff to Four-year Terms."

Amend said Resolution by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the  
following:

'Effective date. Resolved: That the amendment herein  
proposed, if adopted, shall determine the term of office of sheriffs  
to be elected at the general election in November, 1976, as well as  
the terms of sheriffs thereafter to be elected.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the first  
election for sheriffs with 4-year terms shall be 1976.
